Twinning Project: Aim

To establish a more balanced distribution of expertise in in-transition countries by improving capacities in:
Diagnostics, Surveillance and Disease control



Final aim: to establish OIE Reference
Laboratories (Ref Lab)



Twinning Project

In the globalisation era infective diseases must be fought where they originate by creating and supporting structures answering to the concept

One Planet, One Health



The OIE Twinning carried out by ICT, Italy

- Botswana: CBPP, June 2008-August 2010
- Cuba: CBPP and Epidemiology, July 2008-October 2010
- Eritrea: Brucellosis, September 2008-December 2011
- Tunisia: BT, October 2010, in progress
- Namibia: Food safety, November 2010, in progress?
- Tunisia: Food safety, January 2011, in progress

NECESSARY REQUISITES OF CL

The relevance of the disease in the country/region





NECESSARY REQUISITES OF CL

The Twinning Project (TP) is a tool to acquire

recognised competence on a specific disease and

CL must have Departments with "basic standards": Diagnostics, Media & antigens production, etc.



NECESSARY REQUISITES

CL must have full political-financial support by its own government: Equipment, Personnel, Training

..... but not only



REQUISITES

At the end of the project, technical performance may be good but a Ref Lab is overall expertise

Professional experience





REQUISITES

Professional experiences is acquired over the years

 Professional experience assists in becoming a scientific point of reference within the Region



To reach this objective a "Transition period" is sometime required



OIE SUPPORT

In the Transition Period
the Parent Laboratory (PL)
must be in the position to provide
assistance to CL or newly appointed
Ref Lab

&

PL must find the resources for this activity



FURTHER STEP

Facilitating establishment of collaboration network (CN)
A tool to become a scientific Reference Point

FACILITATING COLLABORATION NETWORK

 Establishing network means establishing relation with all laboratories active in the Region and
 identifying complementarities

FACILITATING COLLABORATION NETWORK

OIE Regional Delegate together with Regional FAO & AU-IBAR
Delegates should be active actors in the establishment of the network

FACILITATING COLLABORATION NETWORK

 CL should have a budget allowing Focal Person to visit neighbouring countries to acquire a recognised scientific status



AUDIT

Definition and standardization of audit:

- Objectives of audit: financial/scientific
- Check list
- Auditors should have knowledge of the Region in which they operate
