October 2008 reports from the field in Somalia

- Moderate to substantial floods occurring in the Shebelle and Juba river valleys of Somalia
- Increasing the risk of RVF transmission to susceptible livestock population in the area
- Posing a risk to human health as well







Response to increased RVF outbreak risk

- Raising Community awareness
- Targeted training in RVF clinical cases detection and risk reduction and distribution of PPE to commercial slaughterhouses operators FAO Somalia
- Reducing the risk of vector transmission of RVF to livestock through the extensive application of pour on to a high proportion of the livestock population in flooded areas FAO Somalia Ministerial staff.
