

#### **WTO:** Functions






- Negotiate multilateral trade rules
- Implement trade agreements
- Resolve trade disputes
- Review national trade policies

# WTO Agreements relevant for "veterinary legislation"

- General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade (GATT 1994) - Article XX(b)
- Agreement on the Application of Sanitary and Phytosanitary Measures (SPS Agreement)
- Agreement on Technical Barriers to Trade (TBT Agreement)



## The SPS Agreement: purpose



recognizing right to protect human, animal, plant life or health



avoiding unnecessary barriers to trade





### The SPS Agreement: purpose

establishes a multilateral framework of rules and disciplines to guide development, adoption, and enforcement of sanitary and phytosanitary measures

applies to SPS measures which may, directly or indirectly, affect international trade

promotes harmonization based on standards of Codex, OIE, IPPC



## SPS Agreement: coverage

"Members have the right to take sanitary and phytosanitary measures necessary for the protection of human, animal or plant life or health, provided that such measures are not inconsistent with the provisions of this Agreement"



## SPS Measures: Examples



#### A measure taken to protect:

Human or animal health or health

from

risks arising from additives, contaminants, toxins or diseasecausing organisms in foods, beverages or feedstuffs

limits on residues in fish & shellfish



limits on aflatoxin residues in nuts



## SPS Measures - Examples



A measure taken to protect:

Human life or health.



plant- or animal-carried diseases or from pests

requirement that susceptible animals be vaccinated against rabies

## SPS Measures - Examples



A measure taken to protect:

Animal or plant life/health

pests, diseases, disease-carrying or causing organisms

measure to prevent introduction of FMD



measure to prevent introduction of fruit flies





## SPS Measures - Examples



A measure taken to protect:

Territory of Member



other damage caused by entry, establishment or spread of pests

measure to prevent introduction of zebra mussels through ballast water of ships

#### SPS measures include all relevant

- laws
- decrees
- regulations
- requirements
- procedures



#### SPS measures include inter alia:



- ✓ End product criteria
- √Processes and production methods
- ✓ Testing, inspection, certification, approval procedures
- ✓ Quarantine treatments
- ✓ Sampling procedures
- ✓ Methods of risk assessment



## Key provisions of the SPS Agreement

- 1. Non-discrimination
- 2. Scientific justification
  - Codex, OIE, IPPC (the sisters) → harmonization
  - risk assessment (techniques of sisters)
  - provisional measures (use info from sisters)
  - least trade-restrictiveness
- 3. Equivalence (guidelines of sisters)
- 4. Regionalization (guidelines of sisters)
- 5. Transparency
- 6. Control, inspection and approval procedures
- 7. Technical assistance/special and diff. treatment (facilitate participation in work of sisters)

Key role for OIE

#### The SPS Committee



- Monitors implementation
- Develops guidelines
- Forum for addressing trade problems
- Co-operates with relevant int'l organizations







Who is on it?

- · All WTO Members
- Observer governments (acceding members)
- Relevant intergovernmental organizations (including Codex, OIE, IPPC, World Bank, FAO, WHO, ITC, SADC)

#### Conclusions:

- Countries encouraged to participate in work of "sisters" and SPS Committee
- Coordination among SPS/Codex/OIE/IPPC contact points key to successful implementation
