### **EXISTING LEGISLATIONS**

- Animal (Diseases and Imports) Act, (ADIA)1981 (Veterinary Services, SAA)
  - Part IV Import and Quarantine;
    - I. "Import of animal products prohibited except under license." -
- 2. Food Act, (FA) (Food Unit, Dept. Of Public Health MOH)
- 3. Trade Tax Act (TTA) MOF
  - Meat products are classified as restricted items requiring a permit to import.

#### Weakness

Under TTA, dairy products are classified as treated goods, thus not requiring a permit for importation.

# 2. IMPORT REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Import/Export Division (Trade Tax Regulations)
  - 1. Permit from the Ministry of Finance
- 2. Competent Authority (VS)
  - 1. Import Conditions

### MONITORING AND INSPECTIONS

- Office clearance of documents/certificates from exporting country
- Examination and sampling of products
- Joint investigation (VS and MOH) in case of public complaints
- Recall of products
  - Defective
  - Unwholesomeness etc,

# ANIMAL PRODUCTS CONTROL ACTIVITIES

- Inspection of animal products (upon request) at the port of entry- (ADIA)
- Sampling and Monitoring (FA)
- Premises and storage facilities inspections
- Inspection and certification of specific animal products for exportation.
- Investigation of suspected animal products complaints.

## **FUTURE PLANS**

• Revision of existing of ADIA to cover non regulated products ("treated products" under TTA)
