INTRODUCTION

- **The institute of veterinary services is part of Ministry of Agriculture, Rural Development and fisheries that consists the coordination, execution, of politics and strategies in domino of national animal husband**



CONTINUATION

- **The institute of veterinary services has the legal instruments that define and regulate activities in the field of production, technology, industry and animal health and veterinary public health.**



LEGISLATION

- **Angola in the regulation of the farming activities and veterinary public health adopted:**
 - **Law 4 / 04 of August 13, 2004, the Animal Health Act. This bill repeals the regulations of livestock services, health and livestock animal industry for the years 1931 and 1932 (colonial period)**
 - **Regulation of Animal Act of August 11, 2008**



CONTINUATION

- **The Animal Health Activities sets the general rules governing the production, health, trade, import and export of animal products and by-products and veterinary public health throughout the country Regulation of the Law on Animal Health and the instrument which regulates the standards established by the Activity.**




MEAT INSPECTION

- Regulation of inspection of meat from 1974 has 5 chapters and 127
 - - Cap. 1 General Disposition
 - - Cap. 2 inspection ante-mortem
 - - Cap. 3 inspection post-mortem
 - - Cap. 4 Identification of animals and meats
 - - Cap. 5 Penalties



MEAT INSPECTION

- **The inspections are the responsibility of the competent veterinary authority**
- **The skills of the health authority are in Article 6 and 7 of the Regulation and other activities to conduct the inspection and periodic re-inspection in restaurants,**

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CONCLUSIONS

- Therefore exist some legal instruments approved by governor but is necessary to actualize and to profounder those documents
- Is needed to elaborate all specifics regulations in ambit of animal production and public veterinary health



CHALLENGES

- **Capacity and training human recourses of inspections**
- **Construction adequate infra-structures of abate, conservation and delivery**
