




#### Background on Nigeria


- Location West Africa

- Federal System 3 tiers, Federal, States (36) + Federal Capital Territory ... LGAs (774) and 71,060






### Background (contd)

- Focal points for VP established at the 76<sup>th</sup> SG in 2008
- Undertake several tasks on behalf of the OIE delegate on veterinary products (VP) issues
- From 2<sup>nd</sup> cycle training focal points were to work to improve registration, distribution and quality control of VMP nationally and other responsibilities in their ToRs






#### **Activities**


- Facilitation of compilation of comments on 3 VICH guidelines GL 34, 50 and 51
- Completion of the questionnaire on AMR
- Administration / analysis of questionnaires to obtain a baseline data on stakeholders
- Execution of stakeholders' round table meeting






### Questionnaire Administration/Analysis

- Focal points for some stakeholders identified
- Analysis of the questionnaires showed:
  - Some activities are carried out by several organizations
  - Areas of comparative advantage and those with shared responsibilities






### Questionnaire Administration/ Analysis (contd)

Only one organization has a database

• Although collaboration is taking place at level of meetings, no data/ information is being shared and minimal joint activities are being carried out.






### Stakeholders' Roundtable Meeting

  - To establish a network of stakeholders in the regulation of veterinary medicinal products.

• To streamline and harmonize activities of stakeholders and agree on channels for information sharing.




## Stakeholders' Roundtable Meeting (contd)

- Outputs from meeting
  - 8 Organizations participated in the meeting (FDL, NAFDAC, NCS, NAQS, FDF etc)
  - 25 participants attended the meeting

Agreements on the way forward made





 Administration and Control (NAFDAC) Next Steps & Conclusion




### Next steps

- Action plans for implementation of recommendations from the meeting have been drawn up
  - Communication with new identified stakeholders
  - Plans for awareness creation and sensitization of VP end users to be prepared
  - Proposals for survey of veterinary drug residues in terrestrial and aquatic animals
  - collaboration between NAFDAC and NVRI in vaccine potency testing
  - Meetings twice a year

- The various stakeholders need to collaborate to avoid duplication of efforts
- Harmonisation of legal instruments governing activities of NAFDAC and the Federal Department of Livestock
