



Wild life in lebanon

- Wild life reduced to boars , hyenas, foxes
- No real surveillance activities except for wild bird
 - HPAI
 - Lebanon being on the migrations pathways
 - Collaboration with bird watching societies ,
 - Collecting samples during outbreaks : (feces, dead bird , weak birds)

 Putting in place a surveillance plan including the existing wild life species (boars and hyenas in contact with human and livestock in some cases hunting or agressions)
