

The Council

Represents the World Assembly of Delegates

Members elected by OIE Delegates




Functions

- Examines the technical and administrative documents prepared by the Director General and submitted to each Member Country prior to the World Assembly of Delegates
- Approves the OIE's provisional budget and monitors its implementation
- Represents the World Assembly of Delegates between General Sessions



The Regional Commissions

Address specific regional issues



- Bureau composed of 4 Delegates elected for a 3-year term of office by the World Assembly
- Regional Commission Conférences
 - Every 2 years
 - In one of the countries of the region
- Recommendations submitted to the World Assembly for approval and implementation by the Director General
- Entitled to propose adaptations of OIE programmes, strategies, policies and activities to the conditions and needs of the region
- Meet annually during the World Assembly


