  - on issues or factors preventing effective progress along the FMD roadmap





### **TERMS OF REFERENCE - 2**

- Support FMD regional /national strategies aligned with the global strategy
  - guide FMD training and capacity development activities
  - assist resolving problems and issues related to the implementation of regional activities and national strategies
  - promote ownership and enhance the establishing of an enabling environment for the implementation of control programs

  - PCP and PVS experts, as appropriate
  - 1 representative from a regional organization, with preference given to a member of the GF-TADs regional Steering Committee

### **GOVERNANCE AND MODUS OPERANDI - 1**

- Rules of appointment
  - appointed for a three years period
  - chairperson nominated by RAG voting members
  - vacancy declared if no participation in two consecutive roadmap meetings without adequate justification
  - can be renewed
- Rules of attendance
  - Confidentiality undertaking
  - Conflict of interest <-> his/her own country








### **GOVERNANCE AND MODUS OPERANDI - 2**

- Members of the RAG
  - work in close collaboration with the GF-TADs FMD WG
  - support from OIE and FAO regional offices and the GF-TADs FMD WG
  - report to:
    - GF-TADs RSC
    - GF-TADs FMD WG
  - follow the guidelines/tools of the Global FMD Control strategy







### **GOVERNANCE AND MODUS OPERANDI - 3**

- During roadmap meetings
  - Chairperson: technical report of the outcomes of the RAG meetings (evolution of stages of countries with regard to the PCP-FMD)
  - Network leaders: report of activities of FMD regional networks (epidemiology and laboratory)
  - Decisions on the status of PCP stage-assessment : by consensus of the RAG voting members
    - ❖ 3 CVOs from the region
    - Epi network leader
    - Lab network leader
