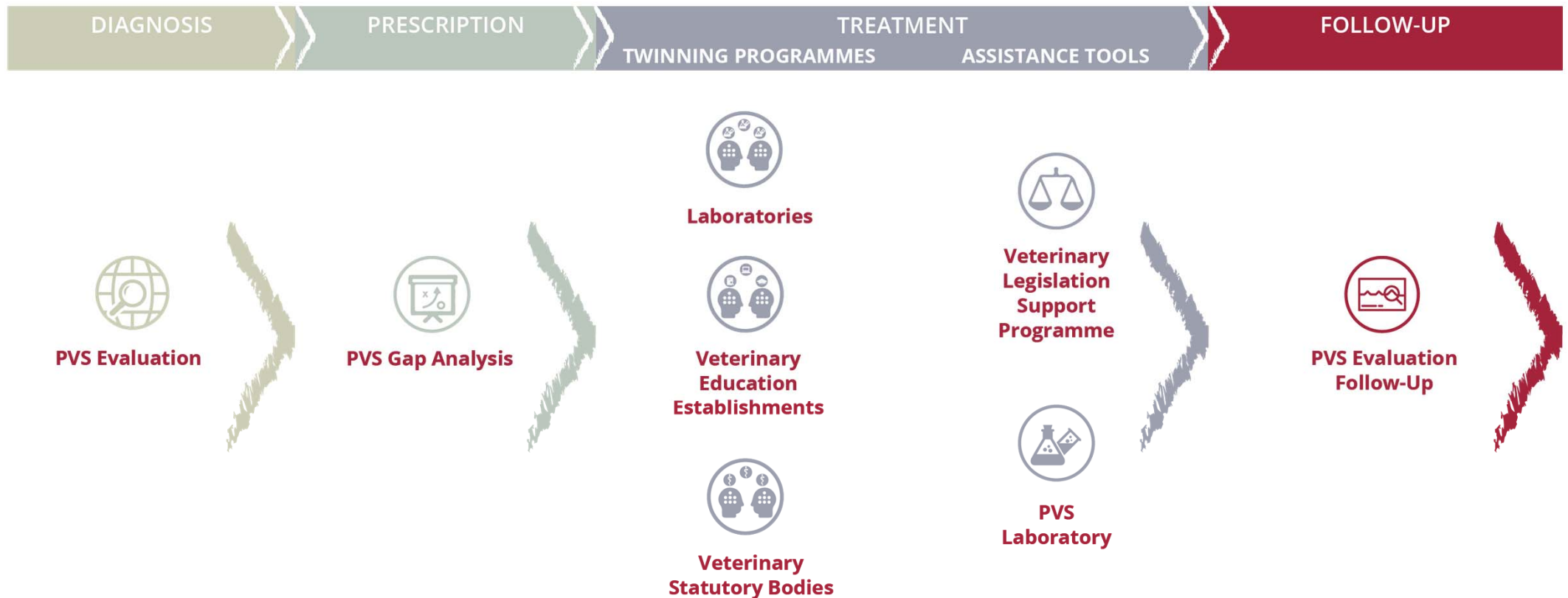

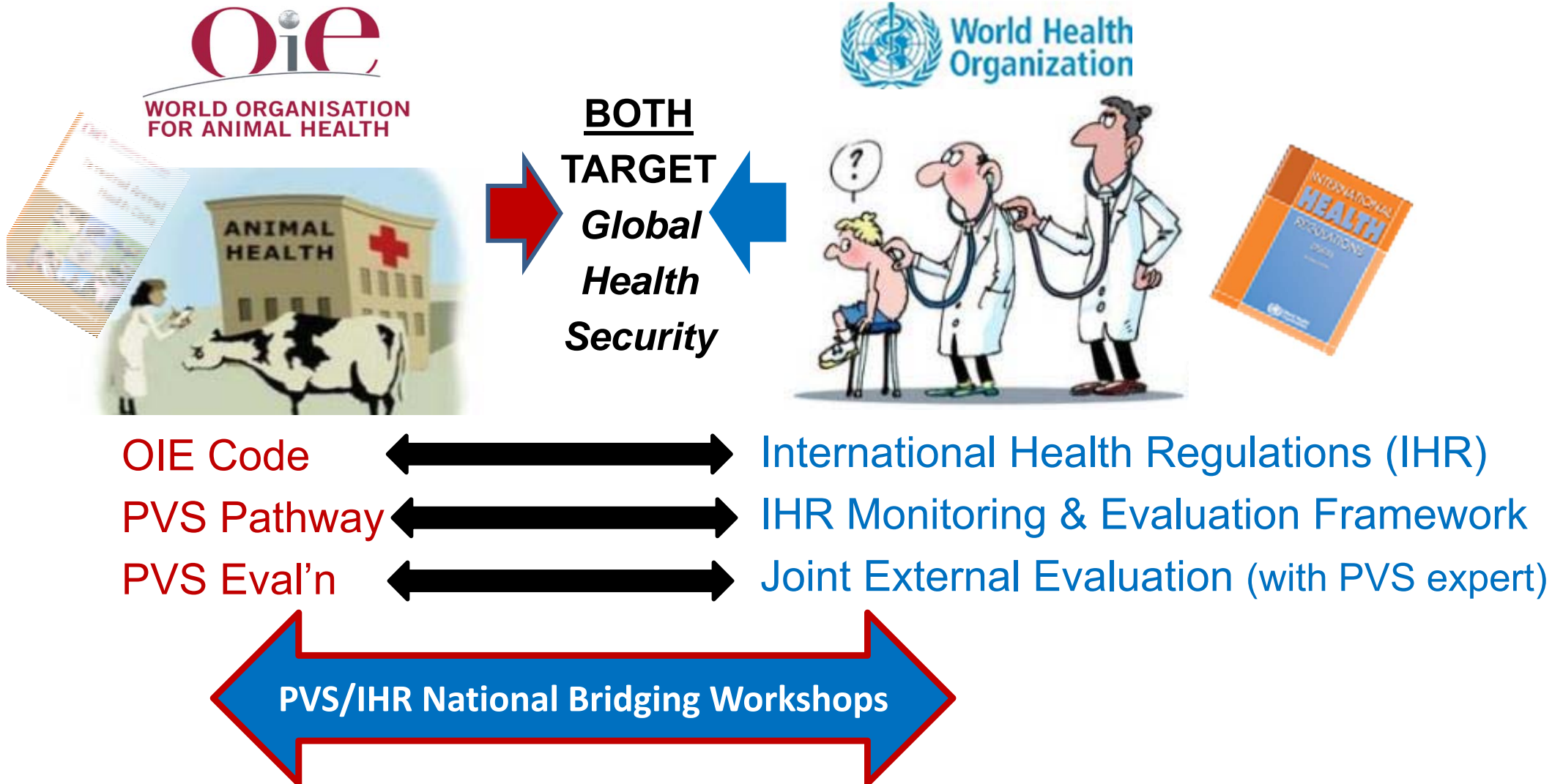
# OIE PVS and WHO IHR Linkages

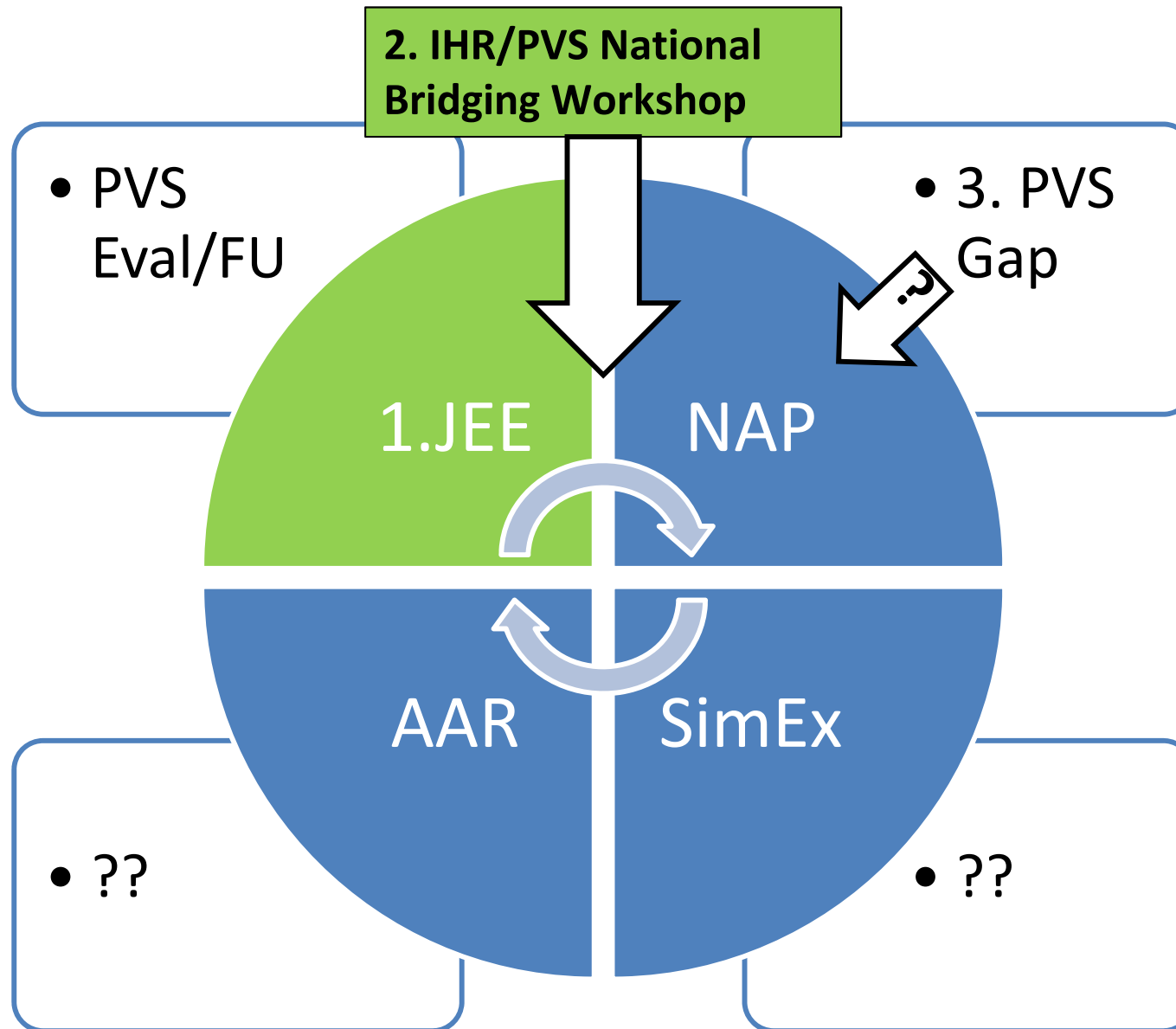
# OIE contribution to JEEs

- PVS Experts on JEE missions – 30 to date, more to come, but slowing down...
- Very well placed to contribute
- Strong need to update PVS in many countries
- Letter to OIE delegate > IHR Focal Point
- ‘Stocktake’ teleconference with PVS experts – highly supportive

# PVS/IHR National Bridging Workshops

- Around 12 completed so far. Excellent feedback.
- Bridges PVS Evaluation and IHR JEE results - recent history of JEE and PVS missions preferable
- Strong need to update PVS mission in many countries
- Operationalises One Health, improves inter-sect collab'n
- More planned for 2018, with funding available through to 2022, many in Africa

# Targeted Support Option 4B: Veterinary Legislation Support Programme

- A lot of experience in Africa, especially over the last 2-3 years
- VLSP identification missions/agreements
- Regional legislation harmonisation workshops by REC (VETGOV)
- AMR/PPR legislation specific content

# Targeted Support Option 4C: Sustainable Laboratories

2 components:

1. PVS Sustainable Laboratory missions

- Link to VS priorities/needs in depth
- Focus on management/financing/budget
- Balance of buildings,equipment/maintenance, personnel/training, consumables/reagents, sampling = optimal throughput
- Laboratory Twinning
  - Sponsor and candidate laboratories
  - Raises laboratory standards internationally

# Targeted Support Option 4D: Veterinary and Para-professional Education

2 components:

## 1. Veterinarians

- Day One Competencies
- Model Curriculum
- Twinning

## 2. Veterinary Para-professionals

- Day One Competencies
- Model Curricula (pilot missions – ground-truthing)

# Targeted Support Option 4E: OIE Focal Points training

8 OIE National Focal Points:

- Animal Disease Notification, Wildlife, Animal Production Food Safety, Communications, Animal Welfare, Veterinary Products, Aquatic Animals, Veterinary Laboratories
- Supports the OIE Delegate
- To date > regional training every 2 years
- Being re-vamped currently, tighter capacity building and follow-up focus, e-learning option
- Using OIE collaborating centres platform.....
