AU-IBAR TO INTERVENE

- EX-ANTE PVS MISSIONS AND LEGISLATION IDENTIFICATION MISSIONS TO FACILITATE DOCUMENTATION REVIEW**
- EX-POST PVS MISSION TO SUPPORT COUNTRIES HARVEST LOW HANGING FRUITS OR IMPLEMENT QUICK-WINS ACTIVITIES**
- EX-POST LEGISLATION IDENTIFICATION MISSION TO SUPPORT NATIONAL TEAM IMPLEMENT THE RECOMMENDATIONS**

WAY FORWARD- RECOMMENDATIONS

- COMPLETE THE PVS ORIENTATION TRAINING**
- PILOT BACK TO BACK PVS EVALUATION / GAP ANALYSIS MISSIONS**
- DEVELOP NATIONAL AND REGIONAL CAPACITIES ON PVS SELF-EVALUATION/GAP ANALYSIS/STRATEGIC PLAN DEVELOPMENT AS AN INTEGRATED APPROACH**
