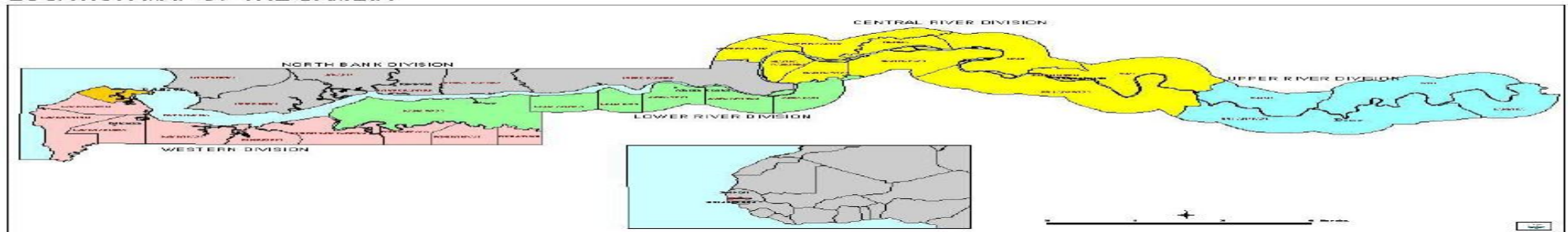


Current activities carried out by OIE FP in The Gambia

LOCATION MAP OF THE GAMBIA

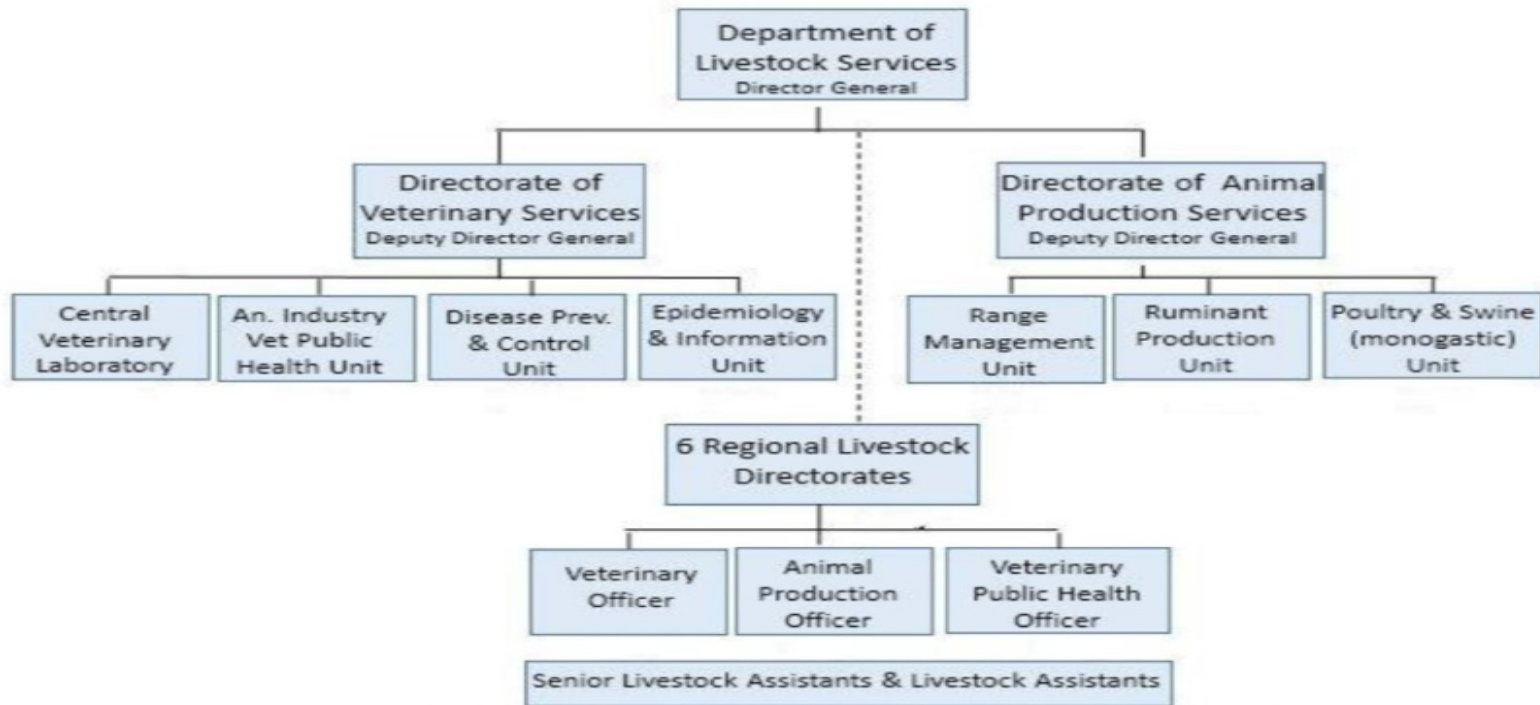

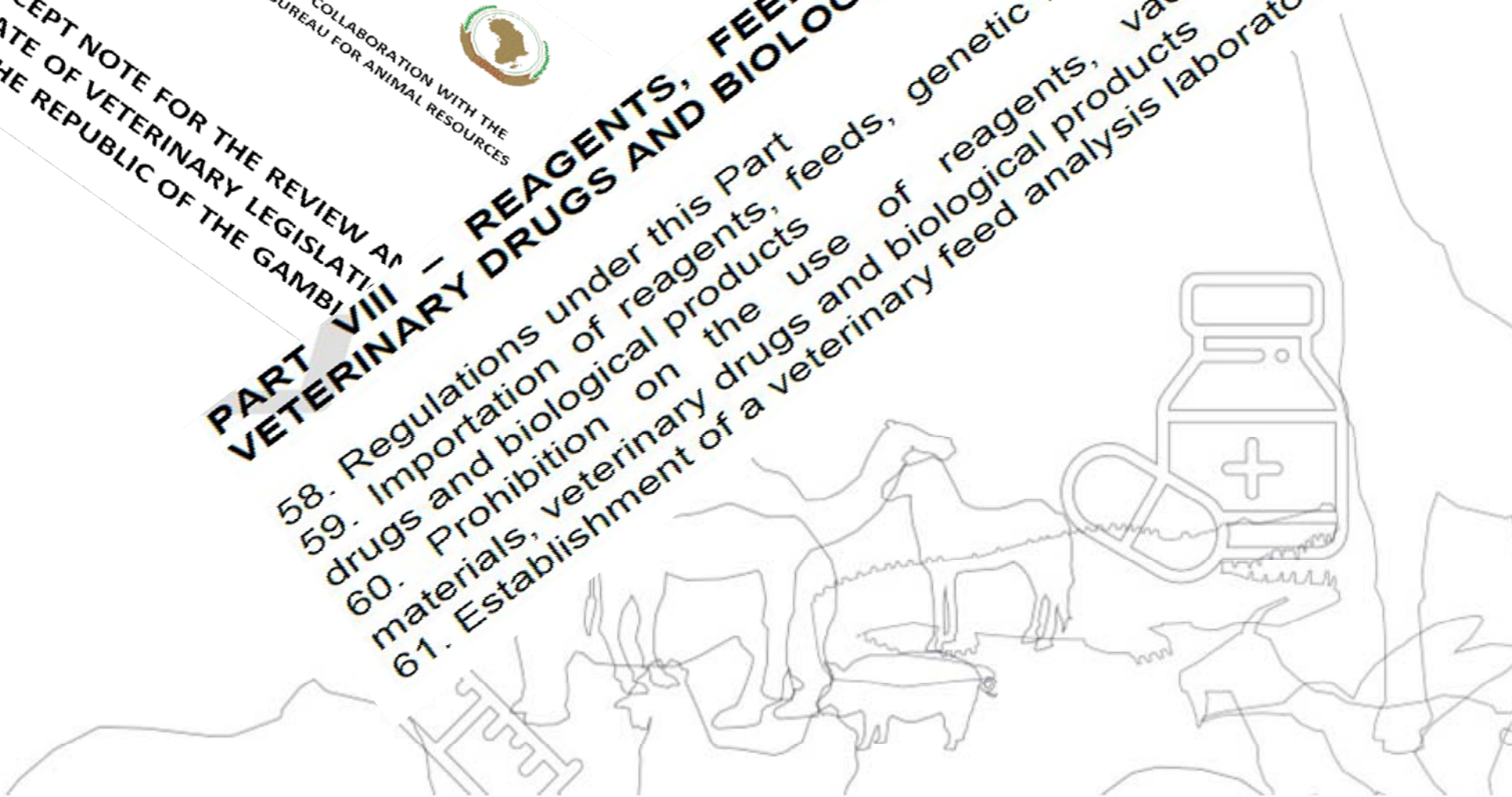
