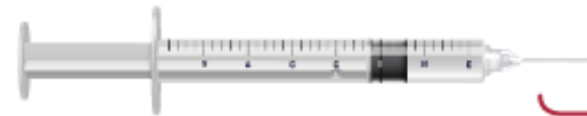
# Webinar objectives
