






Sub Saharan Africa – Aquaculture Production (1950 – 2010)

Categories of aquaculture production systems



Open

- Abalone ranching
- Stock enhancement
- No control of water, environment, animals or vectors



Semi-open

- Suspended baskets for molluscs
- Net pens for finfish
- No control of water or environment
- Some animals and vectors may enter or exit the system.



Semi-closed

- Ponds
- Raceways
- Flow-through tanks
- Some control of water and environmental conditions.
- Animals and vectors may be prevented from entering and exiting the system.



Closed

 RAS with safe water supply

- Control of water and environmental conditions
- Can exclude animals, vectors and pathogens.







Recommendations: Tripartite – WHO; FAO; OIE

- Support member countries to:
 - Develop national action plans to include AMR surveillance in aquaculture.
- Capacity Development:
 - Antimicrobial use (AMU) data collection.
 - Laboratory capacity.
 - Vaccine production.
- Advocate for:
 - Information sharing.







Recommendations: OIE Member countries

- Improve understanding and awareness of AMR.
- Enhance the evidence base.
- Reduction of incidence of infection.
- Optimisation of AMU.
- Compliance to international standards.







Recommendations: SADC secretariat

- Finalise SADC framework on AMR.
- Ensure aquaculture is integral part of SADC framework
- Continuous advocacy and capacity building.
