



The Global Framework for the Progressive Control of Transboundary Animal Diseases (GF-TADs) is a joint initiative of FAO and OIE to achieve the prevention, detection and control of transboundary animal diseases (TADs) and in particular to address their original and global dimensions. The initiative combines the strengths of both international organizations to achieve agreed common objectives. The recently concluded 12th meeting of the GF-TADs supported the establishment of a Partnerships and Financing Panel (PFP) to provide guidance to the GF-TADs governing bodies to better support the efforts made by Regional Economic Communities and countries to control transboundary animal diseases (TADs) along the implementation phase of the GF-TADs Strategy for 2021-2025.






