but without official recognition.**

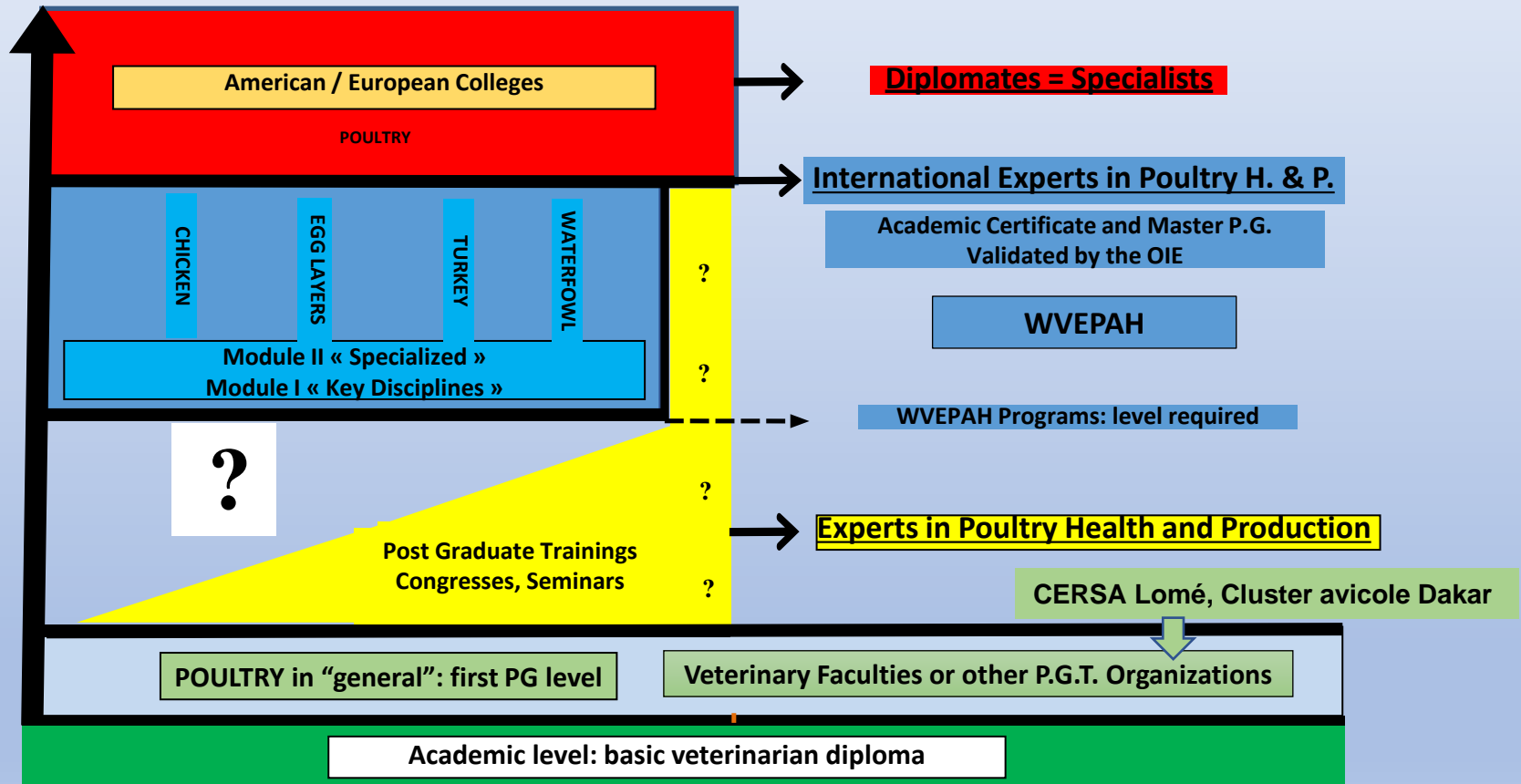
But:

Poultry, Aquaculture, Pork, Laboratory Animals





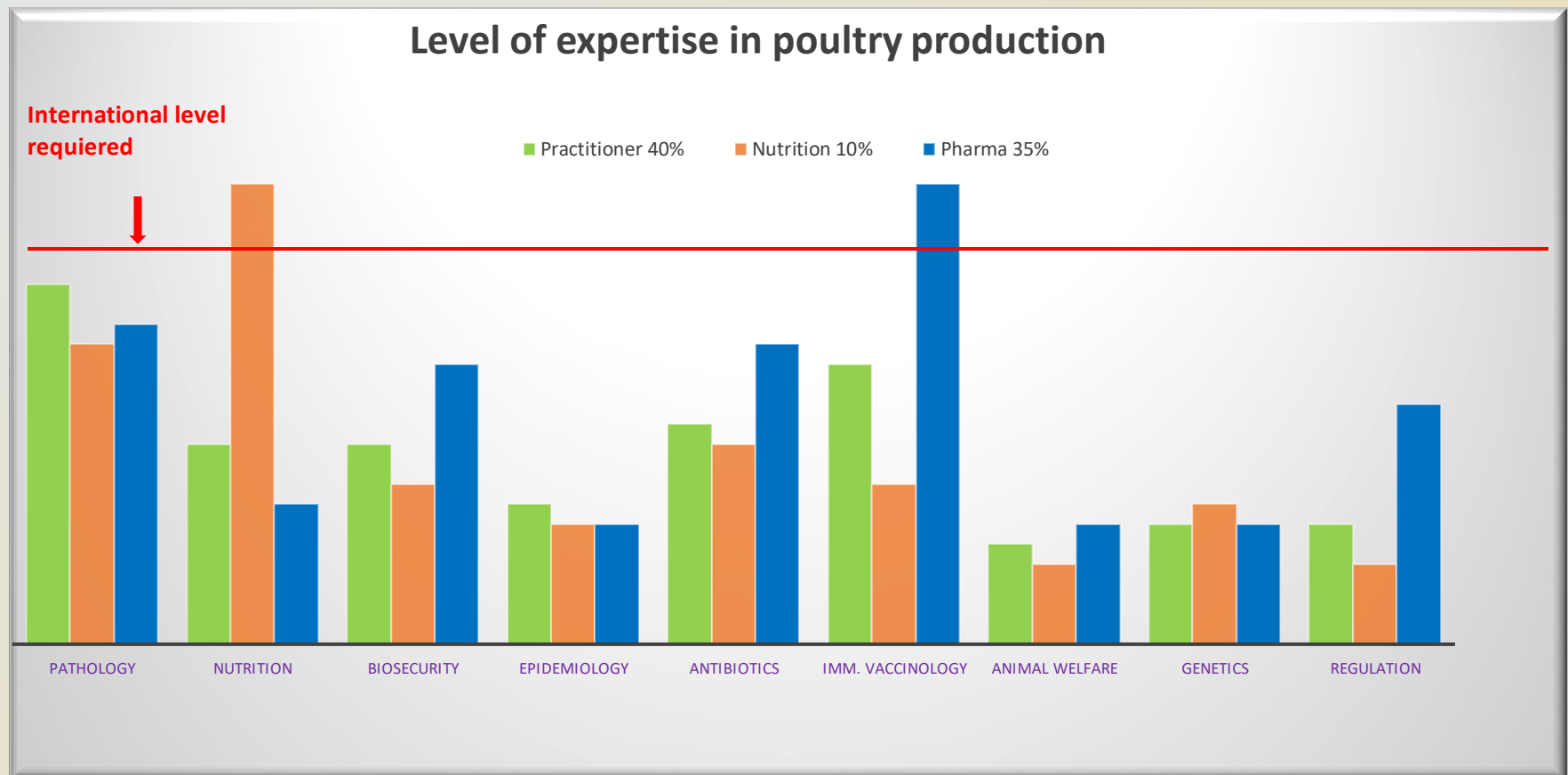

- Zoonotic diseases control → human security
- Customer requirements and needs:

 - Animal welfare
- High standardized post-graduate training required by the WOAH

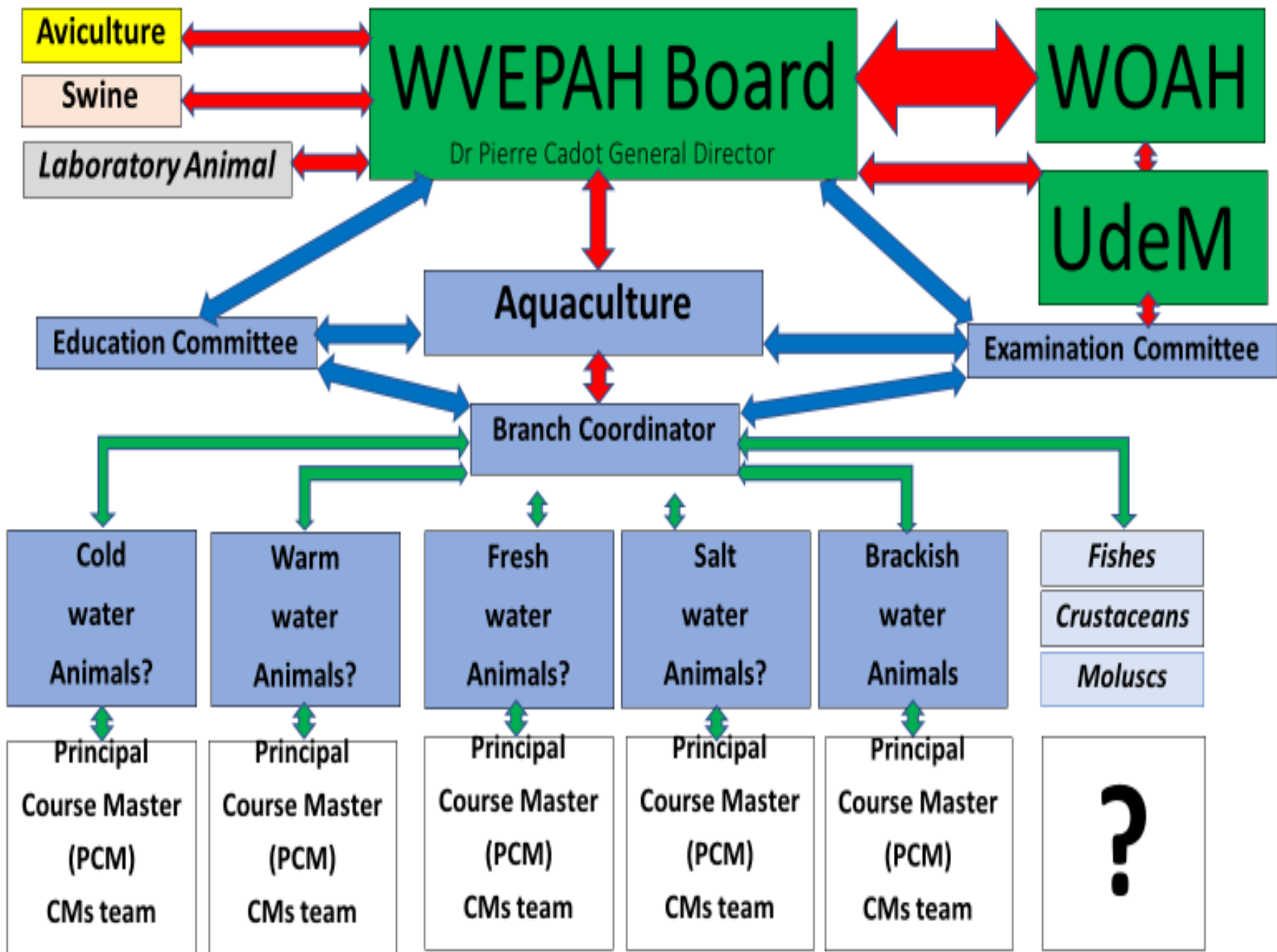
