Terrestrial Animal Health Code

1968 first edition published (different names)

After the World Assembly of Delegates agreed to adopt a harmonised approach to prevent the spread of significant transboundary diseases.





Aquatic Animal Health Code

1995 first edition published

after the World Assembly agreed to adopt a harmonised approach to prevent the spread of significant transboundary aquatic animal diseases.

BUT

fish diseases were addressed in the first five editions of the 'Terrestrial Code', between 1968 and 1986.





WOAH International Standards











World Trade Organization SPS Agreement (Application of Sanitary and Phytosanitary Measures Agreement) ratified;

WOAH recognised by the WTO SPS Agreement as the International Standard Setting Organisation for animal health and zoonoses.

WOAH International Standards





Aquatic Code and Terrestrial Code:

right standards for the improvement of animal health and welfare, and veterinary public health worldwide, including the prevention of disease spread through international trade of animals and animal products.

Aquatic Manual and Terrestrial Manual:

right standards for diagnostic tests and vaccines (*Terr. Manual* only).



Implementation of WOAH standards:

- Improvement of animal health and welfare, and veterinary public health worldwide.
- Facilitates safe international trade of animals and animal products.
- ➤ Contributes to a fairer rules-based trading system by supporting international harmonisation.

Science-based




Specialist Commissions
