Submit your and in correct Follow the work of each Specialist Commission (October and March reports)

Key points:

comments on time format

Review each work programme

Prepare your

comments. including stakeholder consultation

Identify work items of interest for you

Review the relevant part of the report together with the relevant Annex

Assess the state and progress of the work item

- Appoint someone to support you;
- Not all topics may be of the same interest for all Members;
- Topics progress slowly but steadily;
- Takes 2 to 4 years to adopt;
- Engage from the start;
- Commissions rely on Member comments;
- Do not wait until the General Session to comment.
