International/ Global Strategy for CBPP prevention and Control- Why



CBPP is currently confined to Sub-Saharan Africa, its impacts on food security, economic stability, and animal welfare justify the development of a comprehensive strategy. Such a strategy might contributes to global efforts in disease prevention, economic development, and public health.

- 1. Global Food Security and Livelihoods; Economic Importance & food supply chain
- 2. Regional Economic Stability; Economic Integration & Cost of Outbreak Management
- 3. Animal Welfare; controlling of CBPP contribute to the improving animal welfare standards
- 4. Prevention of Spread to Other Regions; reduce the risk of Spread& Strengthening standardized biosecurity measures
- 5. Research and Development Opportunities; improving vaccine and treatment development & building capacities
- **6. Global Responsibility and Solidarity;** addressing CBPP aligns with global health and development agendas, such as the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), particularly those related to poverty alleviation, food security, and economic growth.

Also, a global strategy will demonstrate global solidarity in tackling diseases that primarily affect developing regions, fosters cooperation and shared responsibility in global health issues.



International/ Global Strategy for CBPP prevention and Control- Key components



- ✓ **Standard protocol**: Standardized options for best practices and guidelines;
- ✓ Knowledge Sharing and Collaboration; Knowledge Sharing and Collaboration to foster innovation and improvement.
- ✓ **Resource Optimization**, in a coordinated approach with other TADs.
- ✓ Addressing Global Challenges; , such as climate change, AMR (public health), and social inequality.
- ✓ Research & innovation; Promote Research & Innovative Solutions.
- ✓ Capacity Building, enhance cooperation with international expertise.
- ✓ **Policy Advocacy**; global strategy can strengthen advocacy efforts, influencing international policy and funding priorities to support the eradication of CBPP.
- ✓ **Monitoring & evaluation**; development of global monitoring and evaluation frameworks, allowing for better tracking of progress, impact assessment, and continuous improvement.
