Now in Ethiopia the year is 2017 and currently the month is called 'Tir'. The New Year in Ethiopia is on September 11 and in Amharic the month is called 'Meskerem'.

#### Some information about the Delicious Ethiopian Dishes

Feel free to try Ethiopian cuisine - please be informed most of the dishes are spicy but delicious, and most of the dishes are served with '*Injera*' - staple Ethiopian food which is a thin, spongy sourdough bread.

- If you are a vegan, better to ask for "Fasting Food" in Amharic "Yetsome Migib", some of the common dishes are:
  - 'Yestome Beyaynetu' a vegan food with platter of vegetables and curries made from lentils, chickpea, rice,
  - o 'Misir Wat' Lentil stew
  - 'Shiro Wat' chickpea stew
  - 'Kik Wat' Split pea stew

• There are variety of non-fasting dishes both traditional and non-traditional. The traditional ones include:

- 'Kitfo' (minced meat with butter, served with cottage cheese, kocho false banana bread, cabbage)
- o 'Doro Wot' Chicken Stew
- 'Siga Tibs' Toasted beef or lamb
- 'Siga Wot' Meat Stew

Ethiopia has very welcoming people. Some of the common greeting Amharic words to get you connected with the community are indicated below

'Selam' - to mean Hello
'Ameseginalehu' - Thank you
'Yikirta' - I am sorry
'Ebakih/Ebakish' - Please (for both Male/Female)
Dehna Aderk - Good morning, if greeting a man
Dehna Adersh - Good morning, if greeting a woman
Dehna Aderachihu - Good morning, if greeting more than one person at a time
Dehna Eder - Good night, if a man
Dehna Ederi - Good night, if a woman
Dehna Ederu - Good night, for a group
'Migib' - Food
'Wuha' - Water

#### Location A: Visit to National Veterinary Institute and AU-PANVAC

**National Veterinary Institute (NVI)** is one of the well-known veterinary vaccine producing institutions in Africa. The institute possesses more than 60 years of experience in the production and distribution of veterinary biological products for both domestic and international markets (to more than 26 African countries). The vaccine production capacity of the institute in the early years was about 4 million doses per year, but currently it has a capacity of producing more than 300,000,000 doses.

**The AU-PANVAC** was established as a Specialized Technical Office (STO) of the AUC based in Ethiopia. The Center is at the forefront of the fight against animal diseases as well as zoonotic diseases with its mission to "Promote the use of good quality vaccines and reagents for the control and eradication of animal diseases in Africa". ### **The Unity Park**



The construction of Unity Park was initiated by Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed (Dr.) in 2018 and officially inaugurated and opened to the public on October 10 / 2019. Unity Park is located in the premises of the Grand Palace and it is composed of various historical, natural, and cultural sites. The Grand Palace, where Unity Park is located, was established in 1887 and without counting Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed (Dr.), the palace served as the living and working space of seven Ethiopian leaders. The palace covers an area of 40 hectares and contains myriads of historical buildings and plants that date back to the time of Emperor Menelik II.
