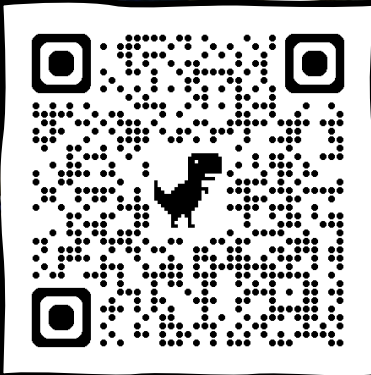


- Four months of intense negotiations

2024 - POLITICAL DECLARATION

- Ten sections* & forty-four commitments
- Till 2029 to implement, with intermediate follow up in 2026
- Four main commitments for animal health
- Thirteen commitments encompassing animal health
- **“A bunch” of commitments for the AMR Quadripartite**

*1) Governance, 2) Financing, 3) Access, 4) Coordinated Multisectoral Response, 5) Human Health, 6) Agriculture & Animal Health, 7) Environment, 8) R&D, innovation & manufacturing, 9) Surveillance, and 10) Follow up





Governance

- #25 - Update GAP by 2026
- #26 – Formalise the QJS on AMR
- #27 - Facilitate multilateral coordination (i.e., UNDP, UNICEF, WCO...) and
- [#28 - Facilitate multisectoral exchange (i.e., MSPP, Ministerial meetings...)]
- #30 - Set an Independent Panel on Evidence by 2025

Financing

- [#36 - Facilitate sustainable funding from international cooperation → 60% NAPs fully funded by 2030]
- #38 – Map existing and catalytic funding



Access / R&D

- #44 – Support global & regional access initiatives
- #45 – increase global access to and appropriate use
- [#93 – Develop research strategies]
- #94 – Strengthen skilled workforces

Surveillance

- #101 – Develop system to monitor AMR in the environment

- Sixteen commitments
- Forty-five endorsements
- Till Dec.31st to express endorsement
- In summary

- Support QJS to achieve many of the UNGA commitments
- Create cross-sectorial mechanisms
- Strengthen surveillance, innovation & awareness campaigns
- Periodic convening of regulatory bodies & agencies
- Encourage implementation of international standards on responsible use
- Set AMR OH Learning Hub & Regional Logistics Hub
- Vet-AWaRe list

14) **Achieve continuity** in the political commitments at each Ministerial Conference **via a Troika System**, involving the former, present and future presidencies, **with the technical support of the Quadripartite** organizations, for the Global High-Level Ministerial Conferences on AMR to **hold Member States accountable on the commitments and progress made.**

16) **Formalize, bi-annually, the Global High-Level Ministerial Conference on AMR, supported by the Quadripartite organizations (FAO, UNEP, WHO, WOA)** and with the next Ministerial Summit to be held in 2026 to take stock of implementable initiatives and progress made.
