Aquatic Code and Terrestrial Code:

Standards for the improvement of animal health and welfare, and veterinary public health worldwide, including the prevention of disease spread through international trade of animals and animal products.

Aquatic Manual and Terrestrial Manual: ➢ standards for diagnostic tests and vaccines (Terr. Manual only).



Implementation of WOAH standards :

Improves animal health and welfare, and veterinary public health worldwide.

Facilitates safe international trade of animals and animal products.

Contributes to a fairer rules-based trading system by supporting international harmonisation.






Process for the elaboration of WOAH Standards




A transparent process to ensure that WOAH International Standards address Member needs. They are developed based on science while taking into consideration different contexts among Members to enable implementation. 8




