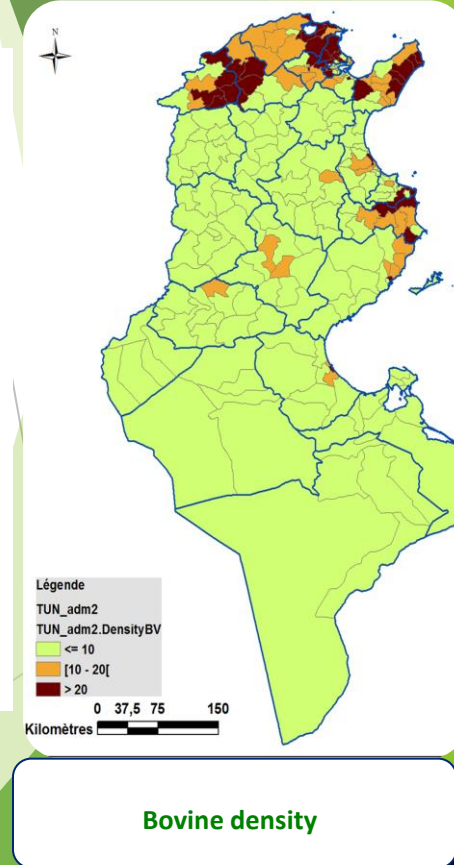
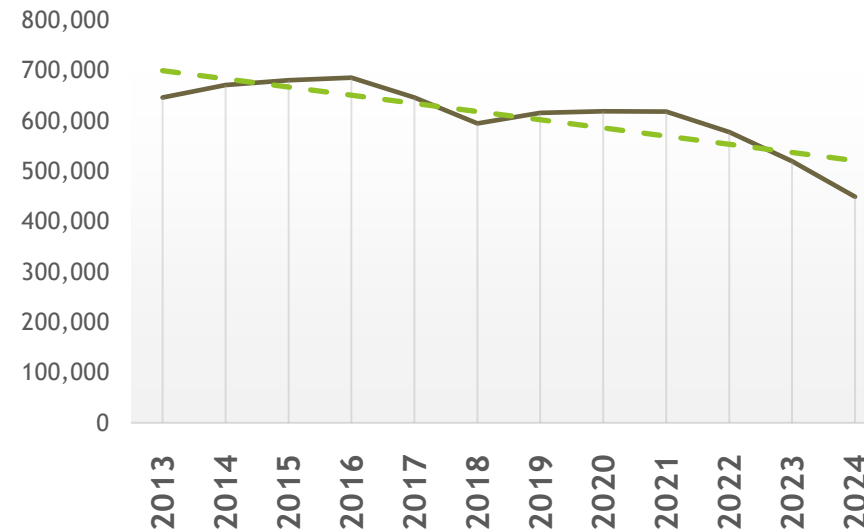

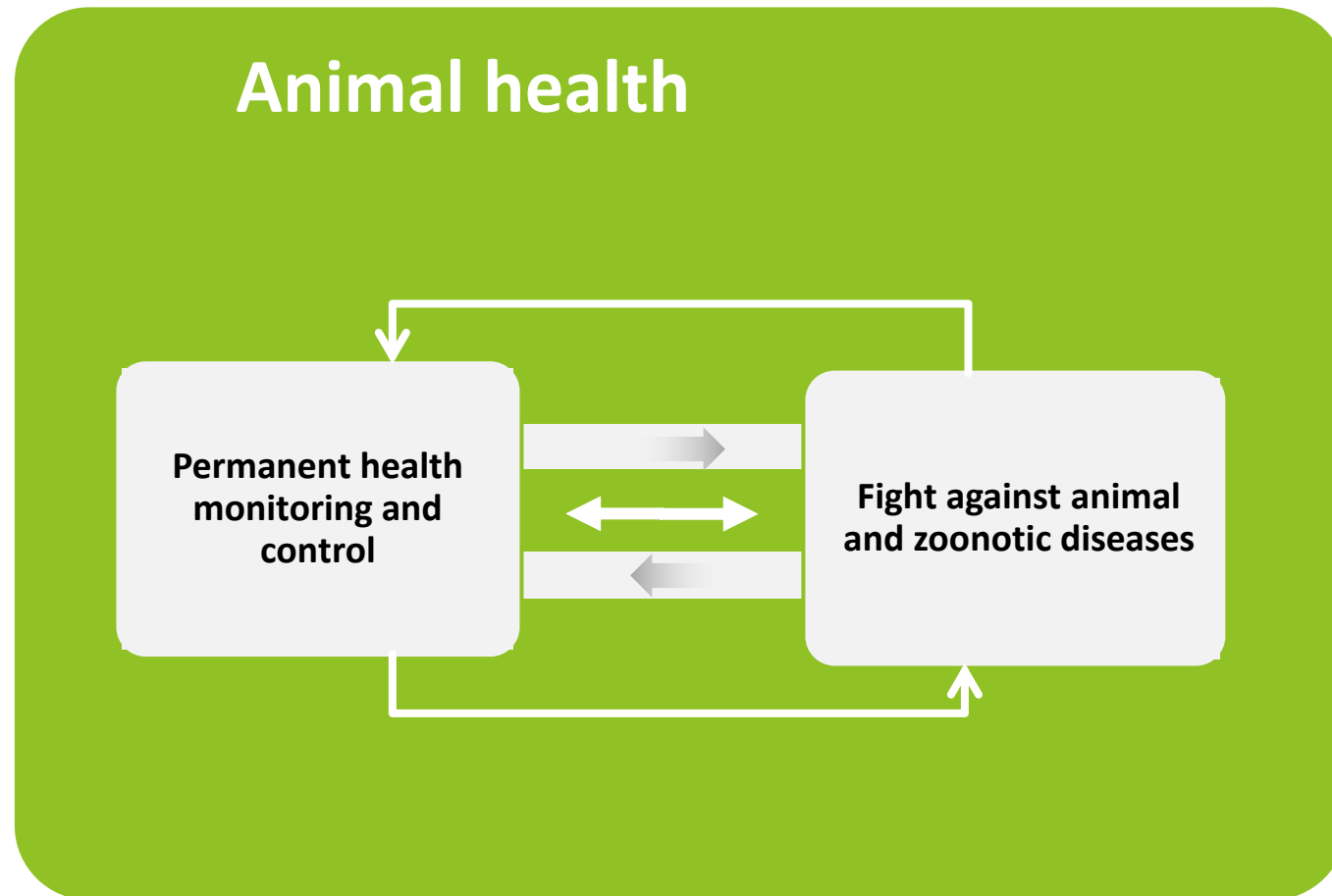
INTRODUCTION

- ✚ The Tunisian economy relies on agriculture, which plays an important socioeconomic role.
- ✚ The agricultural sector contributes 8% to GDP, 9% to export value, and 16% to job creation.
- ✚ Livestock farming accounts for 35-40% of agricultural GDP, or 4-5% of total GDP.

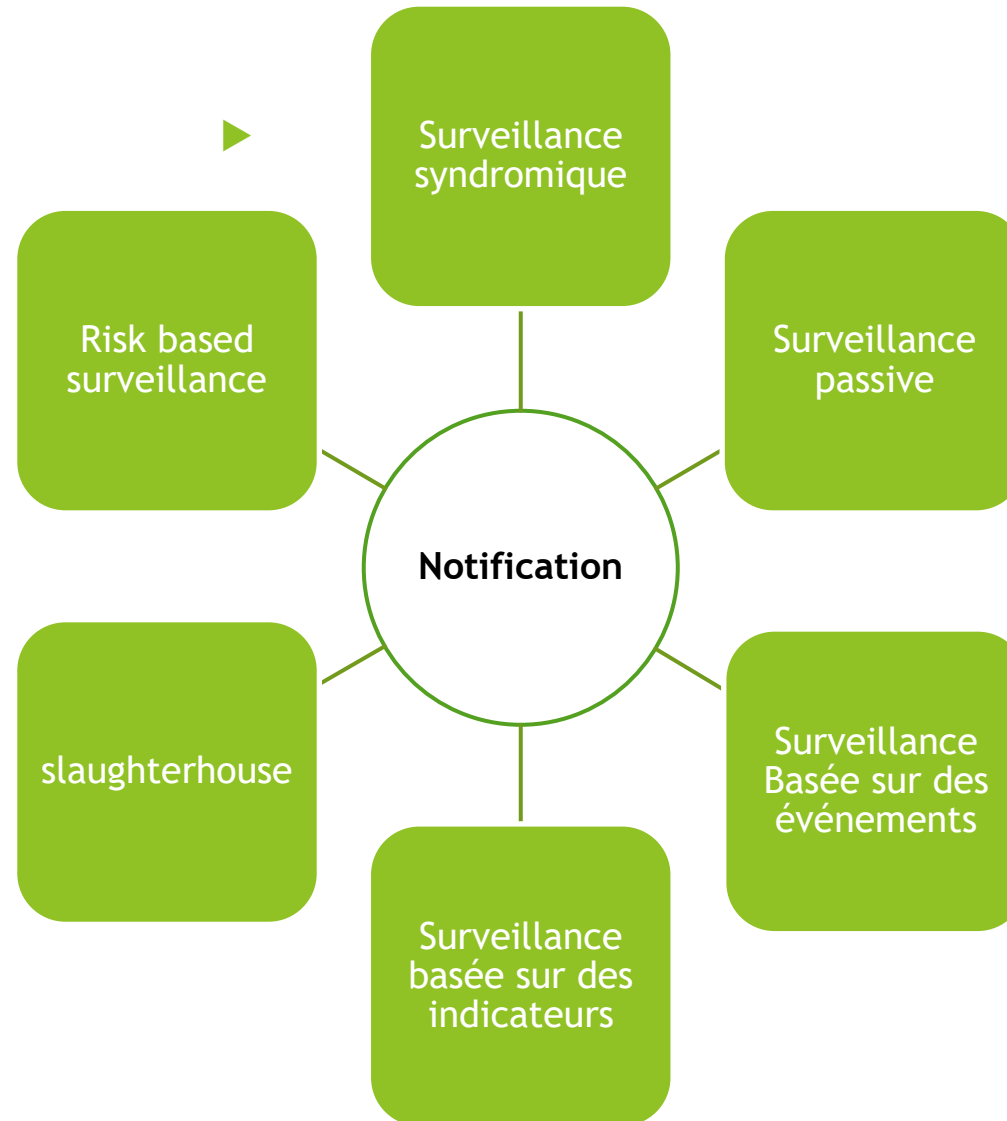

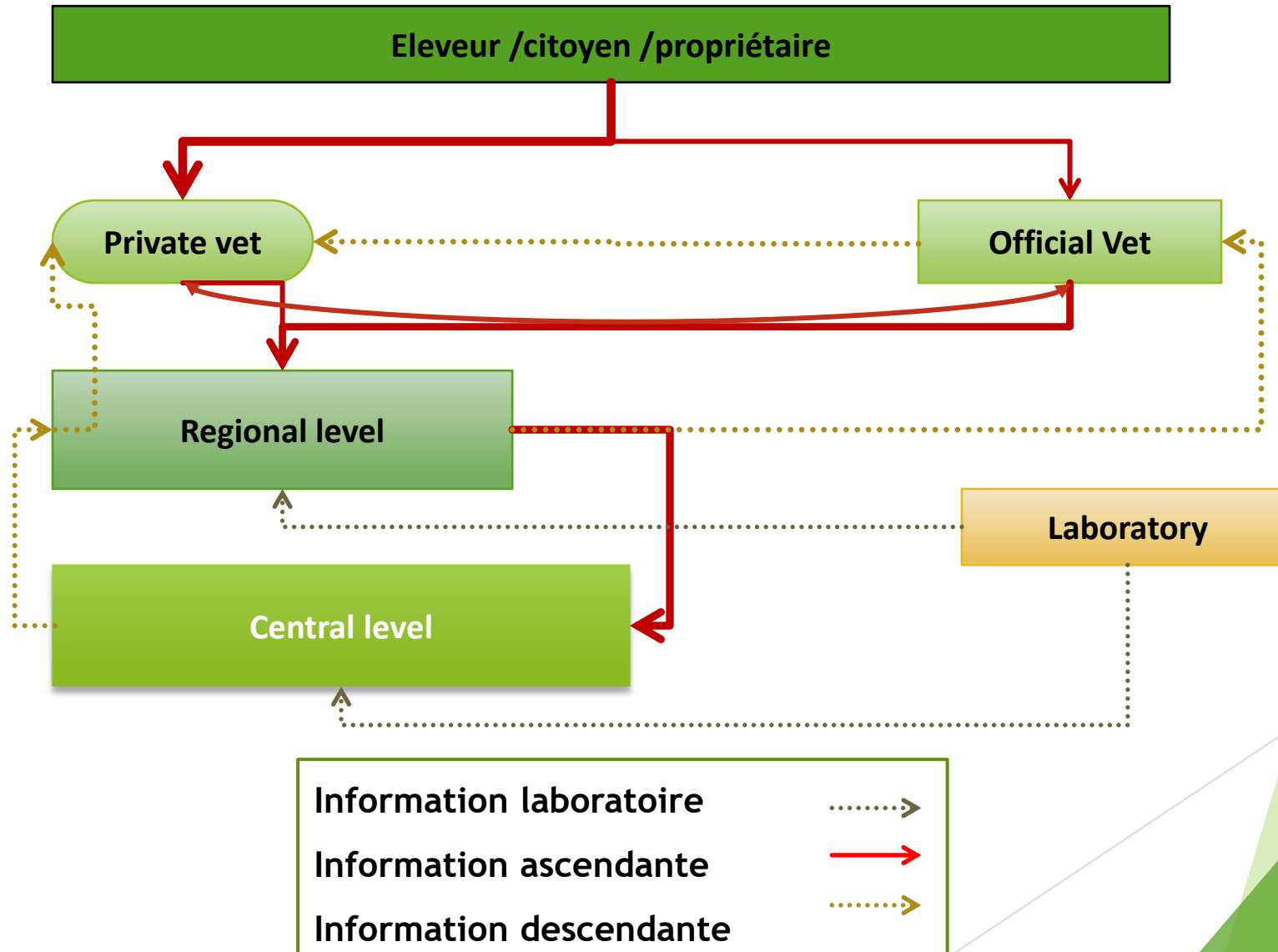

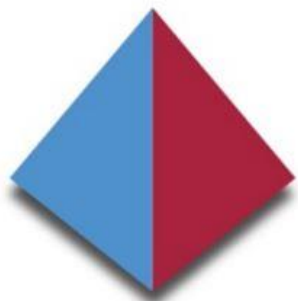
