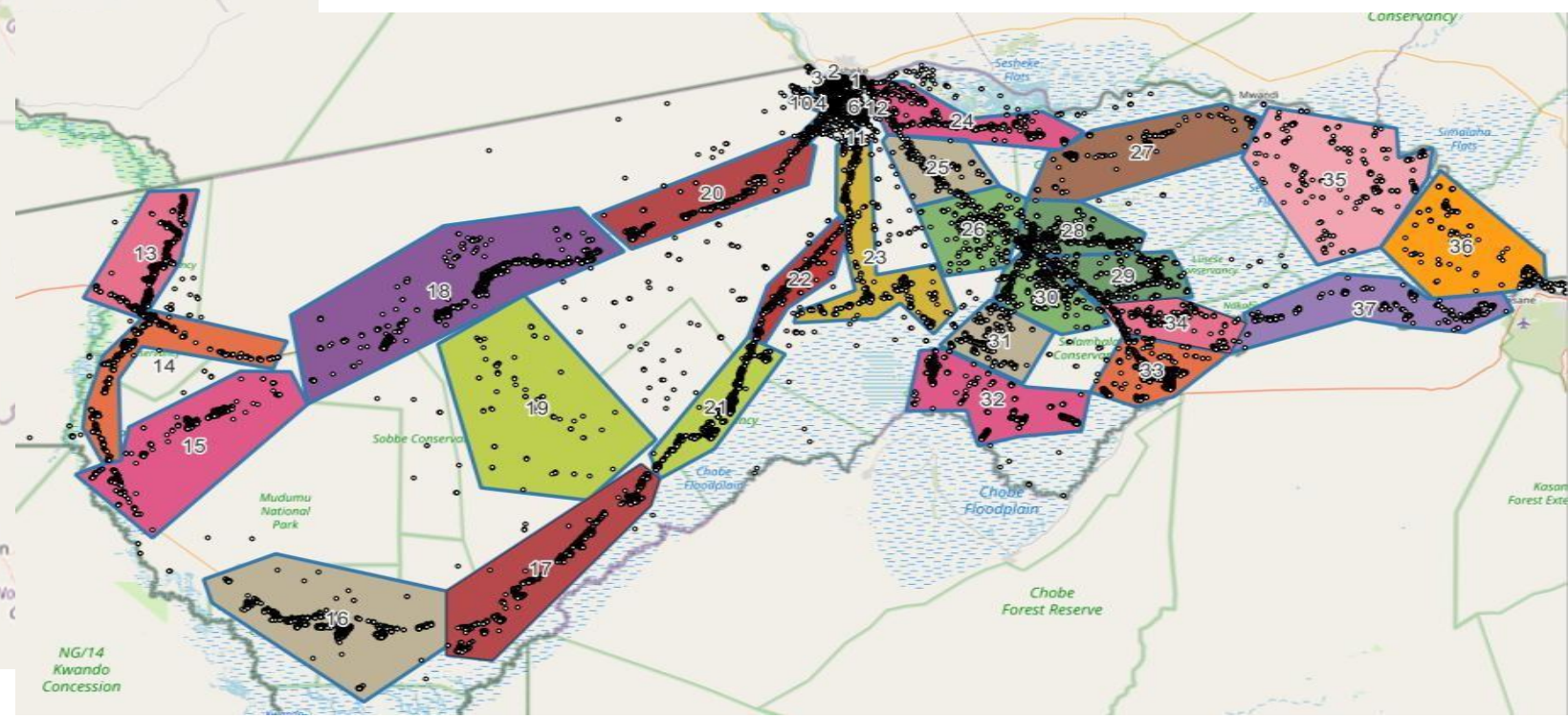
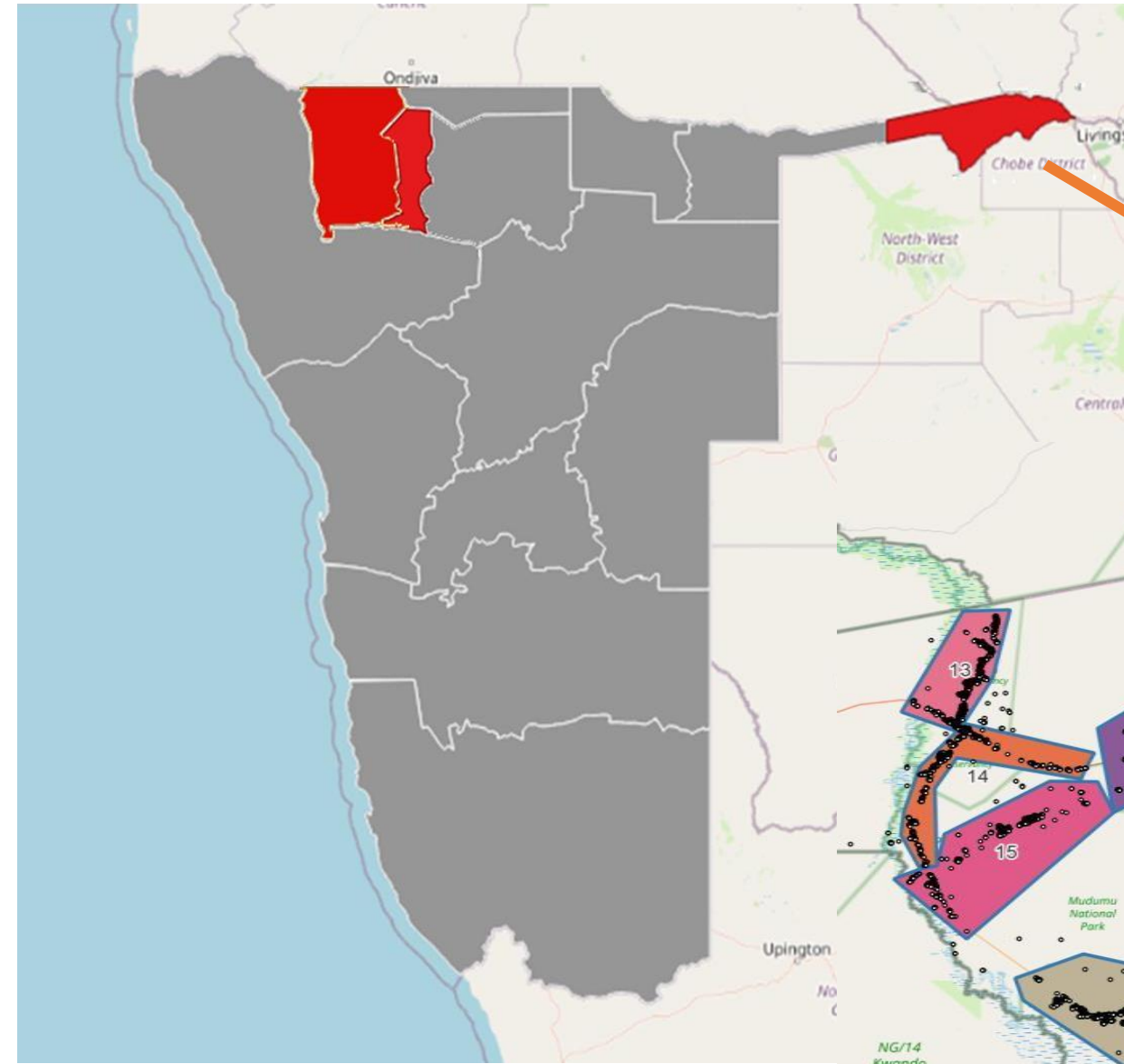

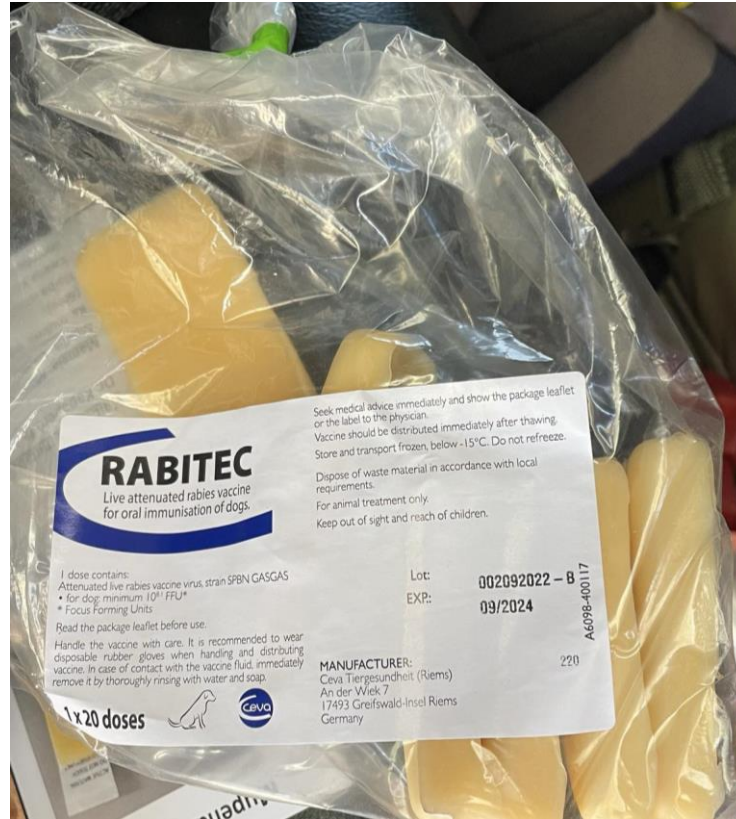

- 20 baits/packet











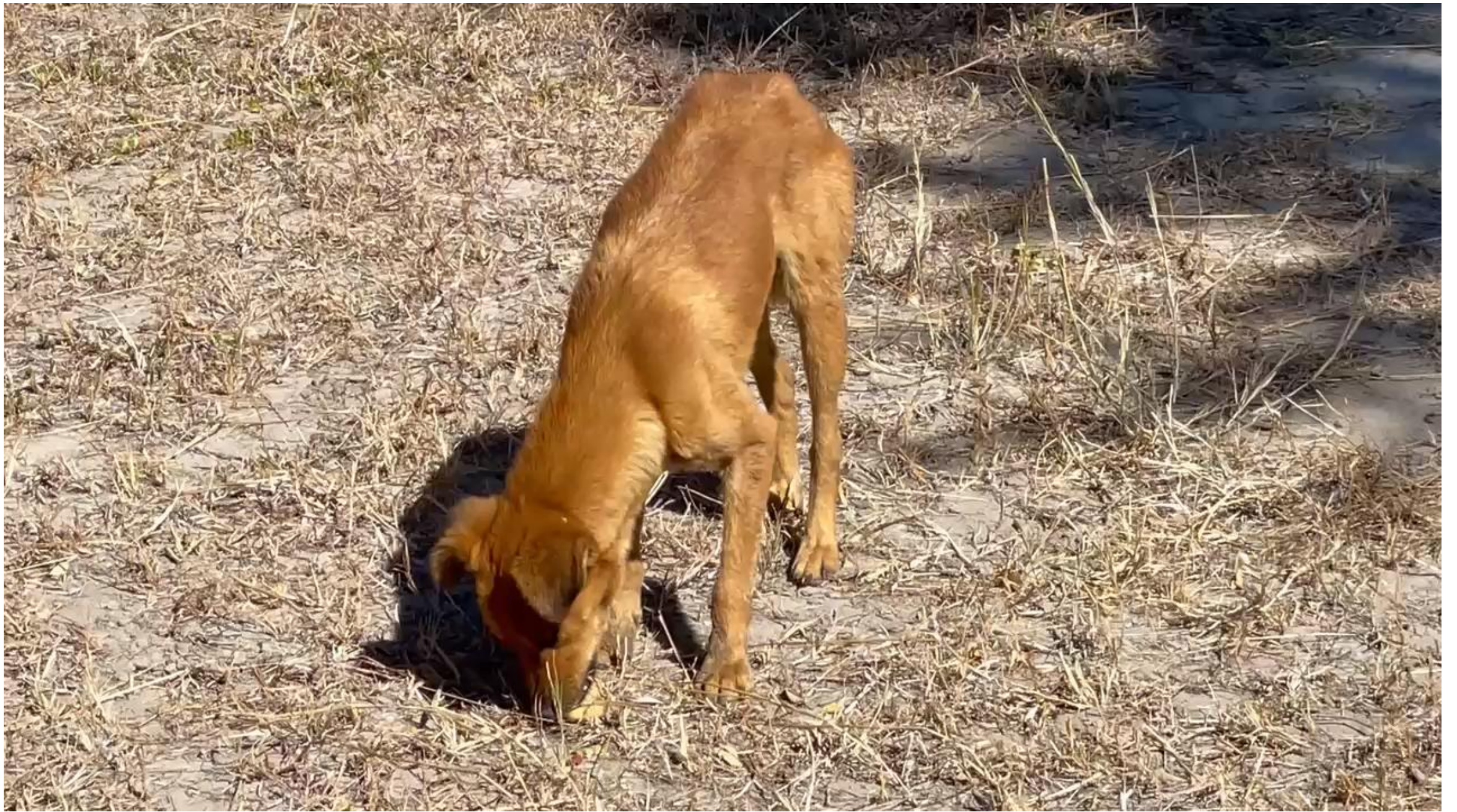


















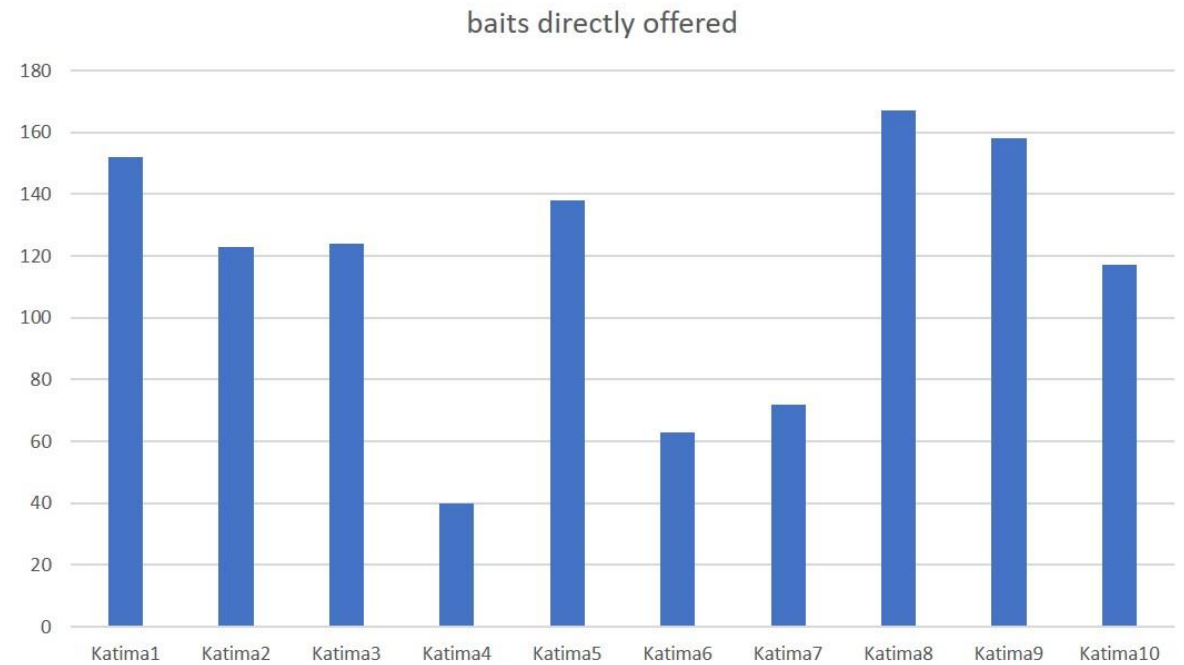


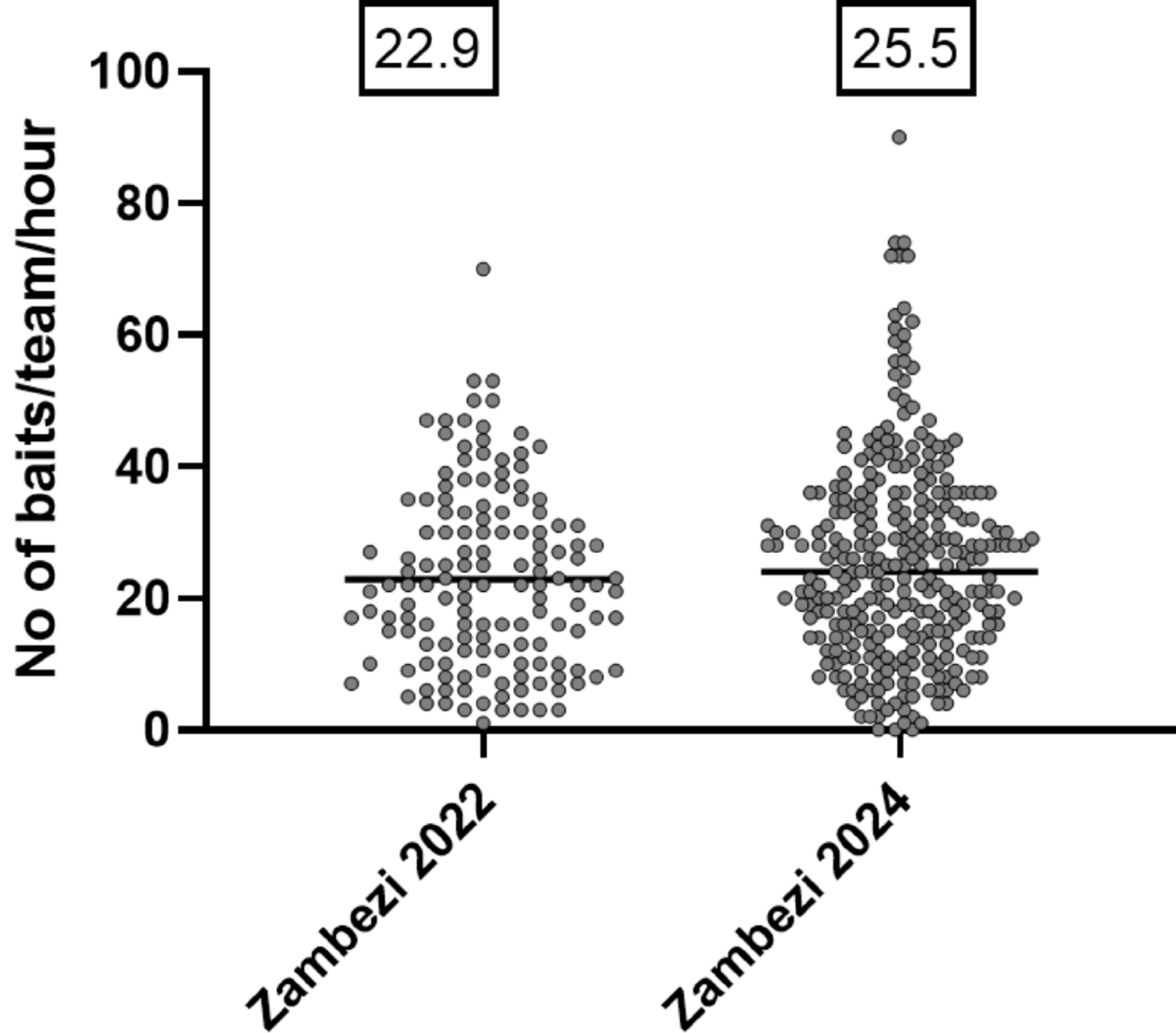

## Analysis Group 2



- 6,5 km distance walking/driving
- 1,65 km/h average speed
- Time needed (total): 3:55 h
- Actual movement 2:44 h
- 104 dogs vaccinated (27 dogs/h)

### Spatial coverage

- Visited zone: 66% of target zone
- 1116 buildings within visited zone
- 1 dog/11 buildings
- 1755 buildings in zone 2
- 157 dogs estimated to be in zone 2
- Vaccination coverage: 64% (100/157)
