Some definitions (1)

- **Monitoring:** this is an ongoing function based on the systematic collection of data relating to specific indicators in order to provide decision-makers and key stakeholders in an ongoing development intervention with information on the extent of progress made, the achievement of objectives and the use of allocated resources
- **Evaluation:** this is the systematic and objective examination of an ongoing or completed project, programme or policy, including its design, implementation and results. It aims to determine the relevance and achievement of objectives, development effectiveness, efficiency, impact and sustainability.



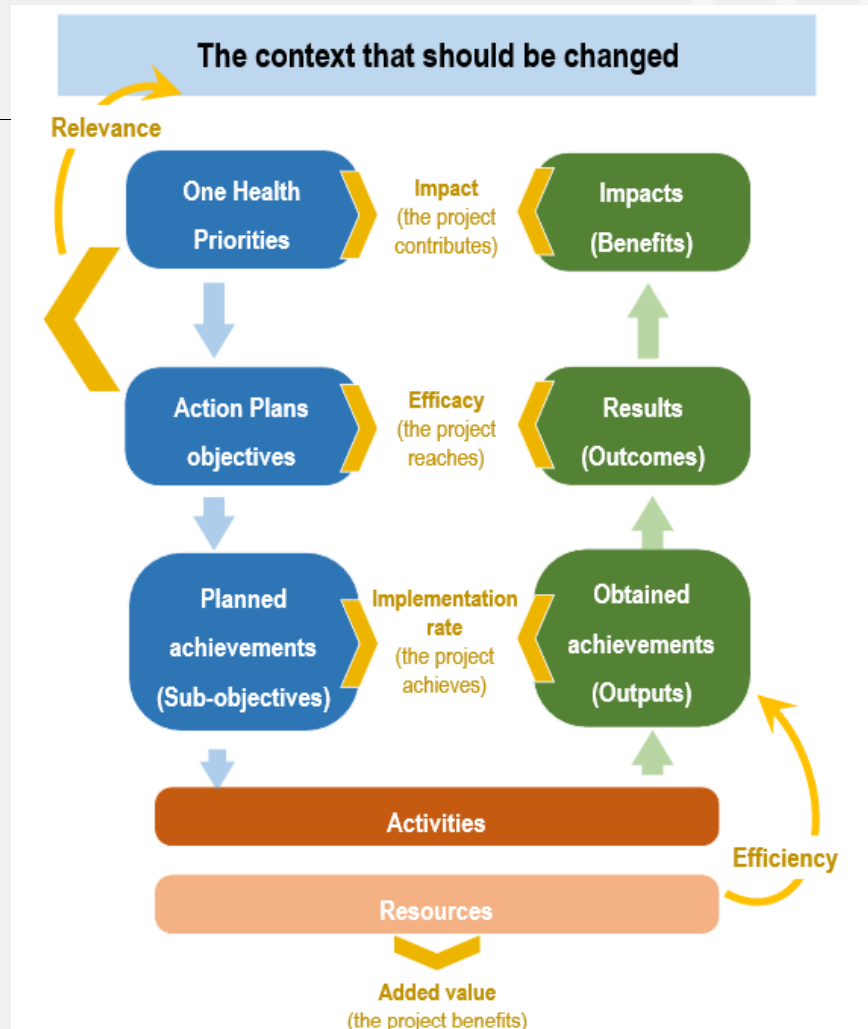
Some definitions (2)

- **Incorporation of lessons learnt:** Learning requires the establishment of systems and procedures to analyse information derived from monitoring and evaluation and to act upon it.

- Output indicators
- Outcome indicators
- Impact indicators
