- Every 10 minutes someone dies from Rabies
- Every year, rabies kills nearly 70 000 people, mostly children
- Over 95% of human cases are caused by the bite of a rabies-infected dog.

Elimination of Rabies is feasible




Dog vaccination is the most cost-effective single intervention to protect humans from contracting dog-mediated rabies

Single Overarching Communication Outcome

Communication strategy



- 1. Situation analysis
- 2. Goals and objectives (Why)
- 3. Define target audience (Who)
- 4. Key messages (What)
- 5. Channels of communication (How)
- 6. Activity plan with assigned responsibilities, timeline and budget
- 7. Plan for monitoring and evaluation

Trust = audience perceptions
