OIE WILDLIFE DISEASE MONITORING SYSTEM

Historical Background

- Since 1993, the OIE has starting collecting data on wildlife using an annual questionnaire
- Since 2008, it was decided that the AHID takes over the working group on wildlife disease notification and collect and analyze on annual basis collected questionnaires
- Since 2008, the questionnaire and disease names have been harmonized with WAHIS using an annual template divided in two six-month periods
- In August 2012 the Excel Questionnaire has been replaced by a new application for notification of specific diseases in wild animals

Annual Wildlife report: *WAHIS-Wild*

Divided in two sections:

– OIE-listed diseases in wild species

- Already entered in the six-monthly reports
- Automatically transferred into the draft Annual wildlife report
- To be provided only after submitting the two six-monthly reports
- Checked, corrected and completed if needed by the focal point for wildlife
- Changes have to be agreed by **Delegate**
- Data will be displayed on WAHID



Obligatory

– Non OIE-listed wildlife diseases

- To be processed by the focal point for wildlife
- Data will be displayed on a specific website






