What is a **PSO**?

PCP Support Officers (PSO)

What is the **role** of a PSO?

- PCP-FMD experts, approved by the FAO/OIE FMD-Working Group;
- Motivate countries to continue FMD control along the PCP-FMD;
- Priority with countries assessed in a provisional stage by the Regional Advisory Group (RAG);














Expected outcomes

 If country assigned a provisional stage, the FMD-WG will send a letter offering the PCP support through a nominated PSO



- PSO will endeavor to:
 - Ensure that veterinary authorities familiar with the PCP principles;
 - 2. Promote and support progressive FMD control through liaising directly with the FMD focal points in assigned countries (provisional stages 1-3)
 - 3. Keep an accurate and complete overview of FMD control activities
 - 4. Regularly report to the FMD-WG and FAO/OIE country and regional offices on activities and results














PSO Terms of Reference

- Liaise with the OIE delegate, the pointsof-contacts for PCP, Epidemiology and Laboratory to support and guide the veterinary authority to complete the PCP Stage and/or to progress FMD control along the PCP
- Follow up on recommendations given by the RAG at regional roadmap meetings
- Tailor support to the individual needs of the country. Keep relevant regional or sub-regional FAO and OIE officers informed about activities and planning















PSO Support

- Support is primarily "desk-based" and may include:
 - Referring the point-of-contact to information and documentation for the country to apply for a higher PCP-Stage
 - Explain risk-based control and management (PCP principles)
 - Provide expertise on FMD issues like:
 - Routes of transmission
 - Economic impact of FMD
 - Risk assessment
 - Diagnostics and PVM
- If funds allow, country missions may occur for specific needs















PSO experience and competencies

Nominated PSOs will have an excellent understanding of the PCP-FMD, understanding of the organization and functioning of Veterinary Services and technical experience with FMD control.



These levels of understanding are reflected by:

- Proven application of PCP-FMD principles and attendance at Roadmap meetings
- Experience in working with national veterinary services
- Contribute to the production of technical documents related to FMD.
