OIE invitation letters to selected number Member Countries and Partners (AU-IBAR, RECs, FAO, donors) to participate in training and for Member Countries to request missions.	OIE finances trainers and national participants.
	AU-IBAR is invited to nominate 3 trainees for each workshop (separate workshops in English and in French).	Merit based pre-selection of national invitees. Submission of CVs by AU-IBAR and REC agencies (for information purposes, no preselection). OIE delivery of training.	AU-IBAR self- finances its own nominees.

2. OIE PVS Missions	OIE-coordinated PVS (or related) missions in Africa. AU-IBAR and/or REC may provide a self-funded observer to the missions. A trained self-funded observer from AU-IBAR and/or REC will be invited on missions.	OIE directly funds missions as per normal processes. AU-IBAR may provide support to the country in terms of planning and logistics
