- Facilitates accurate data reporting






Rabies Vaccination Tracker

- All data stored on the REB and belongs to the government












Measuring the impact of dog vaccination events


- Successful dog vaccination campaigns result in a decline in rabies cases
- Good real-time surveillance relies on rapid and up-to-date reporting and notification





Rabies Case Surveillance


- Facilitates mapping and analysis of all field and/or laboratory-diagnosed cases
- Identifies rabies hotspots
- Accurate record-keeping and tracking
- All data stored on the REB and belongs to the government






